

One Week Intensive Course for English Teachers

“Being More Effective in the Secondary Classroom”

- course dates:** 22nd to 28th April 2007
Sunday evening to Saturday
- course content:** A one week course of 21 hours of intensive English concentrating on
- vocabulary work for the secondary classroom
 - using pictures and other realia in the secondary classroom
 - methods for teaching English using authentic and near-authentic materials
 - developing activities and games for the EFL secondary classroom
 - improving spoken fluency and listening
 - presentations of communicative teaching material suitable for pupils of secondary school age
 - how to “immerse” young learners in the target language
- course participants:** This course is open to secondary teachers from all countries.
- class maximum size:** 10
- accommodation:** half board single room host family accommodation with £20 of lunchtime meal vouchers.
- activities:**
- One Broadstairs familiarisation afternoon with a Charles Dickens theme
 - one half day visit to Dover
 - evening activities including a folk music evening, a cinema visit and ten pin bowling
 - one full day Saturday Cambridge trip with airport departure
- course fees:** £275 (£180 course fees + £95 accommodation)
- optional extras:** return airport transfers, Stansted-Broadstairs-Stansted, for the group: £20 per person
