

## One Week Intensive Course for English Teachers

### ***“Secondary School Didactics and Methodology for Teachers of English”***

<b>course dates:</b>	22 <sup>nd</sup> to 28 <sup>th</sup> April 2007 Sunday evening to Saturday
<b>course content:</b>	A one week course of 21 hours of intensive English concentrating on  <b>Phonetics and phonology:</b> techniques for dealing with students' phonological problems; sentence and word stress; intonation and meaning; correlation between sound and spelling  <b>Effectiveness in the classroom :</b> defining student objectives and devising teaching and learning strategies  <b>Choosing and exploiting authentic material</b> for effective teaching in the secondary classroom  <b>Skills development:</b> listening, reading, writing and speaking exercises; focusing on micro-skills  <b>Remedial teaching:</b> isolating and dealing with particular learner difficulties
<b>course participants:</b>	This course is open to secondary teachers from all countries.
<b>class maximum size:</b> <b>accommodation</b>	10 half board single room host family accommodation with £20 of lunchtime meal vouchers.
<b>activities:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- one Broadstairs familiarisation afternoon with a Charles Dickens theme</li><li>- one half day trip to Canterbury</li><li>- evening activities including a folk music evening, a country pub visit and a quiz evening</li><li>- one full day trip to Cambridge with airport departure</li></ul>
<b>course fees:</b>	£275 (£180 course fees + £95 accommodation)
<b>optional extras:</b>	return airport transfers, Stansted-Broadstairs-Stansted, for the group: £20 per person
