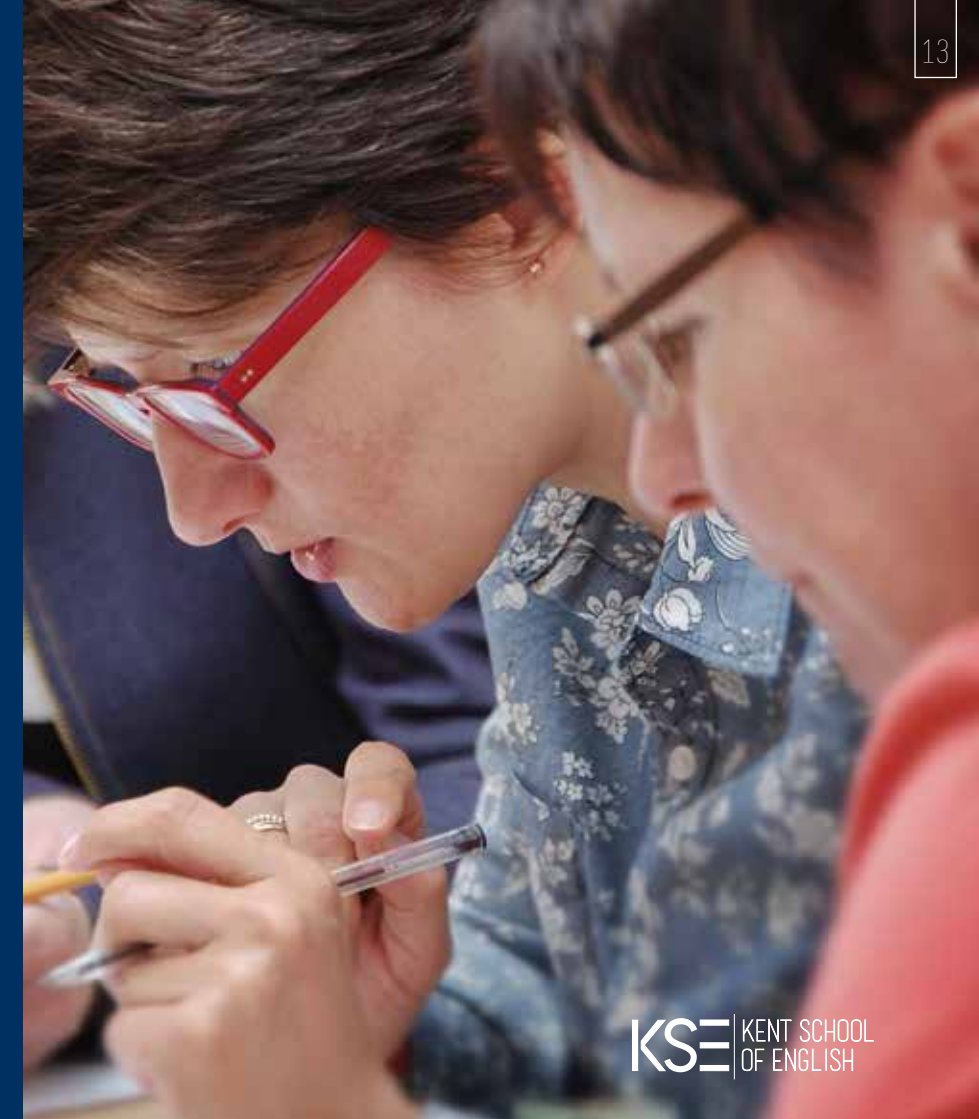


CONSULTANCY AND IN - COMPANY TRAINING

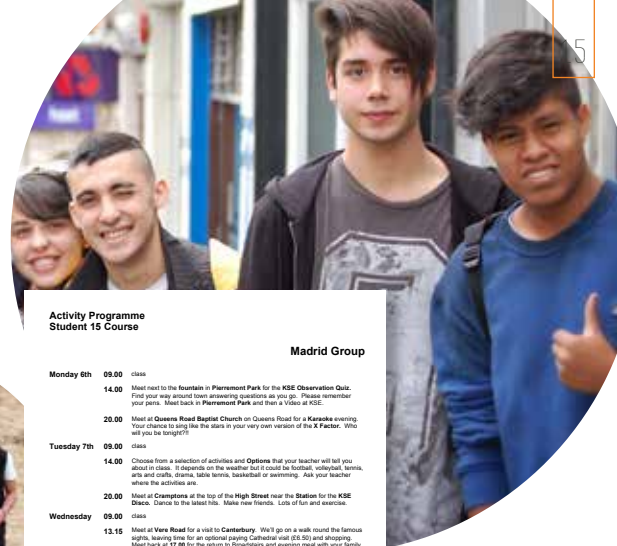
SOCIAL ACTIVITIES

- Full-day Saturday excursion to London
- Half-board homestay accommodation

ACCOMMODATION

Staying with friendly KSE hosts gives you extra opportunities to practise your English outside the classroom.

In homestay accommodation, you have:

- A comfortable bedroom, normally shared with another KSE student
- Breakfast and an evening meal each day
- Weekend lunches at home or on day trips
- Light laundry done and towels provided

RESIDENTIAL COURSES

At Easter and during the summer, we offer residential courses for students in Broadstairs. Our main residential centre is Wellesley House, a very traditional English preparatory school in the heart of Broadstairs.

Wellesley House offers excellent sports facilities, including an indoor swimming pool, beautiful grounds and lovely wood-panelled dining hall. With food expertly prepared by the Wellesley House chefs, you can take your pick from a wide range of choices at breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Residential students can join either the Student 15 or Student 21 course and will enjoy full-board accommodation plus:

- use of heated pool in evenings
- full-day Sunday excursion

KSE staff on duty 24 hours per day to ensure students' welfare and security.



TAILORED COURSES FOR YOUNG PEOPLE

SPECIAL TOPIC

If you're thinking of bringing a group to KSE and you have an idea of something special you would like your students to do when with us, don't hesitate to ask! English and volleyball, English and golf, English and work experience, English and sailing, English and geology - we've designed and run those courses as well as many others. Let us know what your students would like to do!



EXAM COURSES

We are a centre for Trinity College GESE exams, which test English speaking and listening skills. They focus on building motivation and confidence in using English and enable students to chart their progress from beginner to proficiency.



STUDENT WELFARE AND SECURITY

Many of our students are young people, often away from home for the first time and we take their welfare and care seriously. Our friendly teachers and staff are always on hand to answer any questions. Plus:

- Our child protection policies ensure a rigorous vetting and selection procedure for staff and host families
- All students receive a KSE ID card with their name, the address of their accommodation and both school and police phone numbers
- We have a 24-hour emergency line for students, adult learners, group leaders and host families
- As part of our introduction to the school, we make sure that all students receive advice about basic safety, including a reminder that cars drive on the left in England!
- Our staff run crossing patrols in the vicinity of the school, making sure that KSE students can make their way safely to school in the mornings
- In the evenings, KSE security staff are on duty to make sure everybody gets home safely



INTENSIVE TEACHER TRAINING COURSES

- Morning class: 15 hours Monday to Friday
- Afternoon class: 6 hours over 2 afternoons
- Maximum class size: 12
- Four evening activities
- One Canterbury afternoon trip
- One full-day trip to London
- Half-board homestay accommodation

Designed for teachers and student teachers of English and other subjects who wish to become more effective in the English language classroom.

Our standard Teacher Training Courses are one week long, although it's possible to stay for two or three weeks to follow different course topics. TT courses are available to both individuals and groups. All courses can be tailored to the particular requirements of groups. KSE is happy to assist with applications for course sponsorship to government bodies, local authorities and the EU.

The social activity programme is an important part of all our teacher training courses. Four evening activities are organised each week, giving course participants the chance to mix informally with each other and KSE teachers.

LANGUAGE PRACTICE FOR PRIMARY AND SECONDARY TEACHERS

Languages change, English especially, and teachers sometimes feel the need to go back to the classroom to refresh their own English. This course gives teachers an opportunity to practise contemporary English in a multi-lingual situation. Materials are selected which give teachers maximum talking time and every chance to work on both their accuracy and fluency.

TEACHING GRAMMAR

Most teachers are concerned with the need to incorporate grammar, whether explicitly or implicitly, into their lesson planning. This course presents techniques which teach and practise various structures in interactive activities that are both effective and fun to use. Teachers sample a range of techniques designed to remedy particular problems through pictures, games, mini-dialogues and use of authentic materials.

CONTENT & LANGUAGE INTEGRATED LEARNING (CLIL)

The CLIL classroom is designed to enable students to put their language skills to immediate use but can often present challenges for teachers of other subjects. This course is designed both for those teachers and their language-teacher colleagues whose job it often is to help develop and exploit CLIL lesson materials.



GROUP COURSES FOR TEACHERS OVERSEAS

Our KSE teacher trainers are well travelled - we've been running TT courses out of England for many years and have managed to get to a lot of countries!

All our courses are tailored to the requirements of the host institution. Popular topics are:

- The Communicative Classroom
- Teaching Grammar
- Teaching Vocabulary
- Integrated Skills
- CLIL

The course can be of any length from half a day to a full 30-hour week. Please contact us with your requirements and we will be happy to send you a detailed proposal.

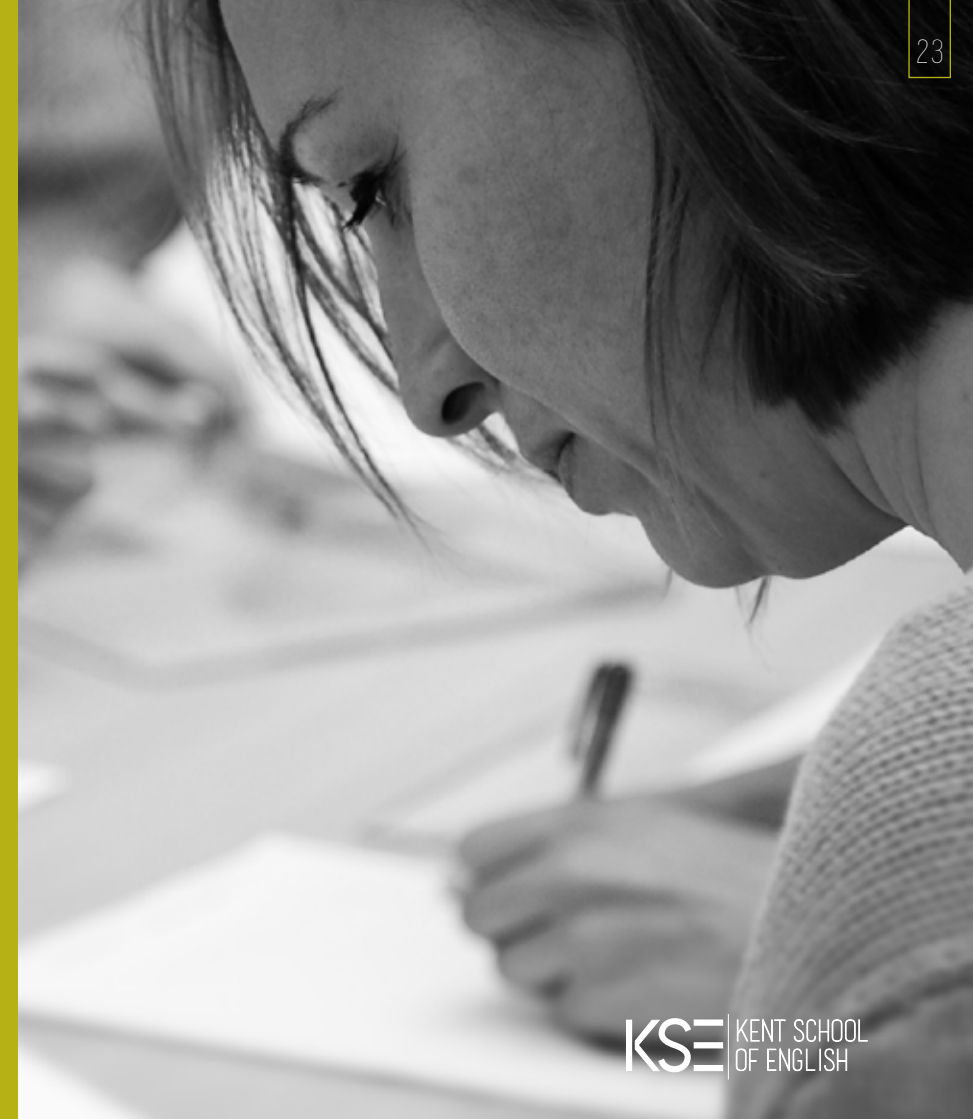

Broadstairs is a charming town. With its white chalk cliffs, long sandy beaches, picturesque pubs and large Victorian houses it is everything you would expect of an English seaside resort. Add in the wide range of things to do in Broadstairs and other nearby towns and you have the perfect location for your course!

- Stroll along the promenade eating fish and chips, enjoy a clifftop walk or explore the sandy beaches
- Try a swim in the sea - refreshing!
- Visit Dickens House to find out more about the great author, who spent many happy summers in Broadstairs
- It's a short bus ride to the Turner Contemporary in Margate where you can find world-class exhibitions of contemporary and historic art
- From the famous Folk Week, to the Blues Bash, the Dickens Festival and the regular music evenings in local pubs... there is always something going on in Broadstairs!
- There's a good selection of independent shops to buy souvenirs and gifts from. Or you could visit Westwood Cross, our local out-of-town shopping centre for clothes shops, bookshops and much more
- Eat in one of the many sandwich shops, cafés and delicatessens in the town centre



CANTERBURY

A beautiful city only 20km from Broadstairs, Canterbury is the weekly destination for a KSE half-day trip

KSE staff will take you on a guided tour of the city, pointing out places of interest and giving you historical background. On the way, you'll see the great city wall and the Norman castle before heading back to the centre.

Canterbury's skyline is dominated by the stunning Cathedral, the oldest in England and the centrepiece of Canterbury's World Heritage Site. It was also the destination for Chaucer's pilgrims in *The Canterbury Tales*, one of the first great works of English literature.

While Canterbury remains a place steeped in tradition, it is also a modern and vibrant city with a bustling shopping area and plenty of independent retailers.

Wandering the lanes and streets of Canterbury is a great way to appreciate the history, architecture and cultural influences which have formed the modern city. Or perhaps you could take a boat tour along the River Stour, which runs right through the city centre.



LONDON



The KSE trip to our capital city, London, is one of the highlights of a KSE course. Our staff will take you on a guided tour of some of the most famous sights of this great city such as The Houses of Parliament, Buckingham Palace and Westminster Abbey.

You'll find out from your KSE guides all about Big Ben and you might be lucky enough to have your picture taken next to one of the mounted soldiers in Horseguards' Parade. You'll walk through the beautiful St James' Park towards Buckingham Palace and then back to Trafalgar Square.

In the afternoon you'll have time for shopping in Oxford Street, Regent Street or Covent Garden or to visit one of the many art galleries or museums, such as the British Museum, Tate Modern, the National Gallery or the Natural History Museum.

LUNCHES FOR STUDENTS IN HOMESTAY ACCOMMODATION

KSE operates a voucher scheme for lunches. The scheme means that for younger students, weekday lunches can be paid for in advance of their arrival at KSE. Vouchers can be used in the approximately 20 shops, cafés and restaurants in Broadstairs, which belong to the KSE voucher scheme. Students are given a list of the places where they can use their vouchers on their first day at KSE.

For weekend excursions, students on Young People's or Teachers' courses receive packed lunches from their host family.



HOMESTAY ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE INFORMATION

ARRIVAL TIME IN BROADSTAIRS:

You should plan to arrive at your host family or residential centre between 16.30 and 23.00

DEPARTURE TIME FROM BROADSTAIRS:

You should plan to leave your host family or residential centre between 06.00 and 10.00

RESIDENTIAL ACCOMMODATION

Students on Easter and summer residential courses have:

- Shared bedrooms or dormitory-style accommodation
- Full board, with breakfast, lunch and dinner in the dining hall
- Packed lunches for full day excursions
- KSE staff on duty 24 hours per day to help with any problems
- Access to sports facilities and games room

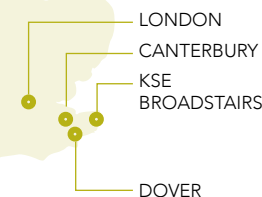

We can arrange coach or minibus transfers from any airport, seaport or rail station. Please contact us for further information.

TRAVELLING TO BROADSTAIRS ON YOUR OWN COACH

Many groups find it convenient to travel to Broadstairs from their home town by coach and keep the coach with them in Broadstairs for the duration of their stay, using their coach for KSE excursions and activities. We offer special discount for groups coming to KSE on their own coach and we accommodate one driver per coach free of charge.

GROUP FERRY BOOKINGS

Please contact us if you would like us to make a foot-passenger or coach and passenger booking for your group with P&O on the Calais-Dover-Calais route.

EN-ROUTE TRIPS

If you have an early flight on your arrival day or a late flight on your departure day, we can arrange a visit for you on the way from or to the airport. If you're landing early at Stansted, for example, you could possibly spend a few hours in Cambridge or London. If you're coming in to, or leaving from, Gatwick or Heathrow, you might like to stop off at Greenwich on your journey.

1. Pay a **deposit of £100** to guarantee your place at the school
2. Pay the remaining balance of your course fees at least **two weeks** before the course start date

Payment should be made in pounds sterling, by bank transfer. Full details will appear on your invoice.

When transferring money from your bank, please note that you are responsible for all bank charges.

CANCELLATIONS

Independent students:

- Please notify KSE as soon as possible of any change to a booking
- It may be possible to postpone a course at KSE (depending on course availability) but deposits are not refundable

Group students:

- Please refer to the conditions stated by the group organiser
